

Social Networking Policy For Parents

The widespread availability and use of social media applications bring opportunities to understand, engage, and communicate in new and exciting ways. It is important that we can use these technologies and services effectively and flexibly. However, it is also important to ensure that we balance this with our duties to the nursery, the community, our legal responsibilities, and our reputation.

As a result, we would ask that parents refrain from:

Contacting staff directly via social media regarding any matter connected to the nursery. If there is a cause for concern or issue needing resolved then the office should be contacted directly via phone, email, or messenger.

Posting photos of children other than their own at nursery events or in photos used from My Nursery Pal. Photo permission has been granted by all parents whose children appear on Peter's Patch social media and website but there are children who are not permitted to be on social media. This decision must be respected by all, always.

Making slanderous or inaccurate statements or comments about the nursery or its' team on social media sites. As mentioned before, if there is a cause for concern or issues needing resolved then the office should be contacted directly via phone, email, or messenger.
